3. Drop in your original artwork and Entry Form by **Monday 5th April 2021 at 3:00PM.**

 - b. **San Fernando** – Courts, High Street, San Fernando (Contact: Ms Stacey Khan Mahabir)
 - c. **Chaguanas** – Courts, Chaguanas, Seereeram Brothers Compound, Main Road, Chaguanas (Contact: Mr Ronald Ramquar)

PRIZES:

Winners and Shortlisted Entrants will have their Artwork on display at Mille Fleurs, one of the Magnificent Seven heritage buildings around the Queens Park Savannah.

RULES:

- Entrants must be between the ages of 6 and 18 years and live in Trinidad or Tobago.
- All entries must be the original Artwork produced by the Entrants only.
- The judges' decision is final.

ENTRY FORM

- Artwork submitted by Entrants can be in the form of a painting, drawing, mixed media or new media artwork based on the theme **Heritage is Me**.
- Entries must highlight the built and/or natural heritage of communities, across Trinidad and Tobago. **Built heritage** includes any individual or group of buildings, structures or monuments or ruins linked to the architectural, cultural, social, political, economic or military history of Trinidad and Tobago. **Natural heritage includes flora and fauna that belong to protected sites as well as other places of natural beauty in Trinidad and Tobago.**
- By submitting an entry, Entrants give The National Trust of Trinidad and Tobago and UNICOMER the right to reproduce the Artwork for as long as is deemed necessary. The winning Artwork as well as entries by Shortlisted Entrants become the property of the National Trust of Trinidad and Tobago and UNICOMER. and such Entrants will be credited in all such Artwork displayed and reproduced by the National Trust of Trinidad and Tobago and UNICOMER. Winners and Shortlisted Entrants may be asked for their birth certificates.
- Staff and their family members of the National Trust of Trinidad and Tobago and UNICOMER are not allowed to enter the competition.
- Entrants and their parents/legal guardians agree that submission of Artwork constitutes acceptance of these Rules. Where it is discovered that an Entrant had breached these Rules, his/her Entry shall be immediately disqualified.
